



Re: The Dryerbox – actual location can vary from instruction sheet

To whom it may concern:

I am the author of the Installation Instructions on the rear panel of the Dryerbox and the inventor. My intentions with the directions posted on the instruction sheet as it pertains to locating the Dryerbox as low as possible and near or on the bottom plate was specifically for standard stand alone type dryers.

For stackable washer/dryer units or dryers mounted on pedestals, The Dryerbox can and should be installed at the proper mid-wall location to allow the dryer transition flex hose to be collected and stored in the Dryerbox receptacle.

For pedestal type units, mounting it higher or even upside down is acceptable so that the receptacle collects and stores the flex hose properly.

Locating the Dryerbox appropriately behind the exhaust outlet of the proposed dryer appliance will provide for the ability to move the dryer flush against the wall and practically eliminate any chances that the flex hose may get crushed or crimped. **The Dryerbox should be facilitating the collection and connection of the flex transition hose but the builder should still retain the option to locate it as they see best based on the circumstances of the job.**

In some cases, the builder may prefer to mount the Dryerbox above the baseboard, perhaps to make it easier for the trim carpenter. Most of the time this practice does not represent the most efficient and safe location, but the inspector should not disapprove this installation. The final location should be at the builders' preference and the instruction sheet should be regarded as the preferred guideline.
